

MID-CAREER ENTRY POINTS

Experience requirements in addition to a university degree

- P-3 = 5 years
- P-4 = 7 years
- P-5 = 10 years
- D1 & D2 = 15+ years

Note: if you only have a Bachelor's degree, 2 additional years experience required



CONSULTANCIES – SAMPLE FUNCTIONS

- Results oriented specialist in a specific area
- Advisory or consultative capacity
- Problem analysis, directing seminars or training courses
- Preparing documents for conferences and meetings
- Writing reports on topics within area of expertise
- Many more functions depending on skills.
- Maximum duration: 24 months in a 36-month period



Ensure that you meet the *minimum requirements* before applying.

Be Concise: Clear and targeted to Job Opening requirements.


Make the most of your experience: Highlight achievements as relates to JO

Targeted approach: Customize your application to fit job based on your background experience and skills.

Review the competencies:

In addition to substantive experience related to specific job requirements, an external candidate becomes more competitive if they can demonstrate soft skills relevant to the specific job opening.




