H.E. Abdallah Baali
Ambassador of Algeria to the United States

H.E. Abdallah Baali became Ambassador of Algeria to the United States on November 5, 2008. Before his current post, he served as Ambassador Advisor at the Ministry of Foreign Affairs and Special Envoy to African and Latin American States. Ambassador Baali also led delegations to various international conferences including that of the Algerian delegation to the Morocco-Saharawi negotiations on Western Sahara. From 1996-2005, he was Ambassador and Permanent Representative of Algeria to the United Nations in New York, during which time he served as representative to the UN Security Council (2004-2005) and as its president in December 2004, as well as vice president of the 54th and 59th sessions of the UN General Assembly. Ambassador Baali also served as vice president of the first Preparatory Committee for the Comprehensive Nuclear-Test-Ban Treaty Organization (1996), headed the delegation to the first and second Preparatory Committee for the Nuclear Non-Proliferation Treaty, and later served as president of the sixth NPT Review Conference. Other posts have included Ambassador of Algeria to Indonesia, Australia, New Zealand and Brunei Darussalam (1992-1996), as well as numerous political and foreign policy advisory roles in Algeria. Ambassador Baali has published articles pertaining to the 1996 Algerian Constitution, nuclear disarmament, and the 2000 NPT Review Conference. He is fluent in Arabic, French, English, and Spanish.
