Ambassador of Indonesia to the United States*

**Dr. Dino Patti Djalal** was appointed as Indonesia's Ambassador to the United States in September 2010. As Ambassador, Dr. Djalal founded and organized the first world Congress of Indonesian Diasporas, has advanced the US-Indonesia Comprehensive Partnership, and worked on Forestry-11, a group of tropical rainforest countries founded to defend their interests in climate change negotiations. A career diplomat, Dr. Djalal joined the Department of Foreign Affairs of Indonesia in 1987, and has since served in the UK, East Timor, and the US, as well as in several prominent positions in Indonesia, including as Director for North and Central American Affairs (2002-2004) and Presidential Spokesperson and Advisor for Foreign Affairs for President Susilo Bambang Yudhoyono (2004-2010). Apart from his official duties, Dr. Djalal's greatest passion is in youth affairs. He is the founder of Modernisator, a movement of like-minded progressive and reformist young leaders, and the conceptor of Generation-21, a program which aims to awaken and develop a sense of unique identity and challenge among youth. Also an accomplished author and academic, Dr. Djalal has published seven books, including a national best-seller. He received his BA from Carleton University in Ottawa, his Masters from Simon Fraser University in British Columbia, and his Doctorate from the London School of Economics.
